established hierarchies of race and gender their feminist impulses in combination with their use of race as a metaphor meyer argues produce at times a surprising if partial critique of empire through readings of jane eyre wuthering heights the mill on the floss daniel deronda and charlotte bronté's african juvenilia meyer traces the aesthetically and ideologically complex workings of the racial metaphor her analysis is supported by careful attention to textual details and thorough grounding in recent scholarship on the idea of race and on literature and imperialism
